

CITATION GENERATOR

So, you need to find sources for a research paper on the topic of drones and privacy. Here are some awesome results that we found in Quick Search. Your professor asked us to use the APA citation format to cite the articles we use for our research assignment. Quick Search has a feature that can generate citations for us.

Once you find several articles you would like to use you can add them to our temporary folder using this button next to the article's title.

Notice how the folder next to the search button becomes populated with the articles we have selected.

Once you click on this folder you can chose your citation format. Our professor asked us to use the APA, so we can scroll down here and select this format as he requested. Also note that we can chose other formats like Chicago/ Turabian, AMA, MLA, Uniform or Harvard.

How can you get this citation list t? The Library website has made this process easy for you. You can either Print or Email it to you using the buttons on the right. Or from the pulldown menu, you can choose to export it to your citation management accounts.

One final word of warning: The citation generator feature In Quick Search can save you time, but the citations are not always correct. Be sure to check the manual for whatever citation style you are using to be sure your citations are good to go.
