

FINDING BOOKS

To find books, we'll begin by using Quick Search on the library website.

I'm interested in learning more about American military history.

Here we see a lot of results. But, we want to narrow them down to just the books and ebooks. I can do this on the left side of the screen under format.

Clicking on a title shows important information like location, availability, summary and a list of chapters.

We see that this book is available and that it's in the Lied Library on the 5th floor.

Here you'll see a bunch of letters and numbers. This is the call number, which is basically the books address in the library.

You'll need that number to find the book on the shelf. There are guides on each floor near the elevators to help you find your book. Or, just ask for help at our research and information desk on the first floor. We also have the option to access electronic books or ebooks. As we look through our results you'll notice this shout out "Full Text Online".

Once you click on the title and you'll see a link to 'connect to this title online', this will take you to the ebook.

If you're not on campus you'll need your ACE account and password to access it.
