Biographical Note: Jean Devlyn (1903-1968) was primarily known as a choreographer. She managed the Jean Devyln Dancers who performed in Las Vegas and Reno, Nevada, as well as other locations in the United States. Devlyn also sketched many costume designs. She lived in Las Vegas, Nevada and choreographed the Las Vegas Press Club's annual variety show. She passed away in 1968.

Matt Gregory Productions designs, approximately 1970s

Biographical Note: Matt Gregory (1921-2000) came to Las Vegas, Nevada in 1953 and began working in public relations for Moe Dalitz at the Desert Inn and the Showboat. He also worked as a talent manager, managing several lounge acts and produced many shows in Las Vegas and elsewhere. He staged his productions on a smaller scale, allowing them to be performed in smaller venues. He passed away in 2000.

Biographical Note: Josephine Spinedi studied classical ballet and art at the Arts Educational School Ltd. in London, England. She began her dancing career in Italy at 16 years old. While a dancer, she used her artistic talent to assist the costume designers. She later came to Las Vegas with her dance troupe and began designing costumes for shows including "Mad, Mod World" and "Fancy That."
