Biographical Note

Maurine Hubbard Wilson (1898-1990) and Fred Holmes Wilson (1896-1958) came to Las Vegas, Nevada in 1925 soon after their marriage. They both played important roles in the cultural life of the city; she as a musician and music teacher, and he as a historian.

Maurine Hubbard was born in Missouri, but moved to Colorado with her parents where she finished her early schooling. It was in Colorado that she met and later married Fred Wilson. In 1925 they moved to Las Vegas, where Fred worked for the Post Office. A trained and talented musician, Maurine was organist for the First Methodist Church for 29 years and taught piano and violin to the young people of the city. Both Fred and Maurine had a deep interest in the history, geology, and archaeology of Southern Nevada. With

his friend Dr. William Park, Fred documented the life of the Las Vegas area in 1929 to 1930 on film. When Fred retired he devoted his time to his hobbies. He collected material on local history, hoping to write a history of Clark County. In addition he collected materials and wrote a history of the First Methodist Church in Las Vegas that was published to coincide with the fiftieth anniversary of that church.
